



2017 Delaware International Speedway Rule Addendums

The following rules differ from the standard RUSH Late Model Rules and will apply to events held at Delaware International during the 2017 season

*(GM 604 competitors please note your differences in red that apply **ONLY** to regular events & excludes the "Battle of the Bay" events that will use regular RUSH rules for 604s):*

- The DIS Engine Seal will be accepted on GM 602s that competed at DIS in 2016
- GM 602 competitors may utilize a 10" spoiler or the standard 8" spoiler.
- The DIS American Racer Tires will be permitted on GM 602s that competed at DIS in 2016 through July 2, 2017.
- The Hoosier CUSA55 is *mandated* on the right rear for GM 604 competitors.
- GM 604s must weigh 2400 lbs or 2375 lbs with the Bilstein Bandit Shocks (50 lb. increase over normal RUSH Rules). The GM 602s remain at 2200 lbs or 2175 lbs with the Bilstein Bandit Shocks. No 1-lb per lap burn-off in the feature.

*Also note: The DIS Engine Seal will **ONLY** be accepted outside of Delaware International for prior GM 602 engine competitors on the following special weekends:*

- April 27-29 (Delaware/Potomac/Winchester)
- May 11-13 (Georgetown/Potomac/Winchester)
- July 1-3 (Georgetown/Potomac/Winchester)
- July 27-29 (Delaware/Potomac/Winchester)
- August 10-12 (Delaware/Potomac/Winchester)
- October 28 (Georgetown Speedway)

The DIS American Racer Tires will ALSO be permitted on GM 602s that competed at DIS in 2016 at Georgetown Speedway through July 2, 2017.
